

Educational Decrees a.k.a. Basic Guidelines

Reading the books is a non-negotiable



Get student input to help set the tone.

"Sort" the students during the initial meeting. Once sorted, students remain in designated house. Use slick Slytherin skills to manage behavior and separate challenging partnerships.

Have enough activities to cycle through 3 years.

Create a few routines.



Routines

"Wands UP!" Students lift their wand (or a finger) in the air and become silent. Use as an attention grabber.

Spells are used to take attendance.

House points are awarded and taken away to manage chaos.

Manage the environment and use props. They don't have to be expensive!





Tables are arranged in 4 blocks, one for each house.

Colored paper corresponds to house colors.

September: Sorting into houses

October: Making poly-juice potion and transforming into someone else. House points awarded for guessing.

November: Painting sorcerer's stones

December: Creating gingerbread houses with a Harry Potter theme

April: Kahoot tournament



May: Party including quidditch and Honeydukes

January: Choose patronus and make a "sparkley" model with plastic animal


February: Create Mirror of Erised from cardboard and tinfoil

April: Houses create maps of areas using ozobots to narrate tour


May: Scavenger hunt to find treats for party
