



Colorado Department of Agriculture Continuing Education Credits

***NOTE: Licensed qualified supervisors and certified operators may obtain TWO (2) Continuing Education Credits in Ornamental Pest Control by attending AT LEAST two of the Ornamental Pest Control sessions listed above. A maximum of two Ornamental Pest Control credits will be given. If attendance at both sessions is not documented on the verification form, then only one credit will be given.
